**43<sup>Rd</sup> -ALL INDIA ENTRANCE EXAMINATION FOR SUB-OFFICERS COURSE**

Applications are invited from eligible candidates through online portal for the 43<sup>rd</sup> All India Entrance Examination for Admission into 45<sup>th</sup> and 46<sup>th</sup> Ex. Sub Officer Course to be conducted during the year 2020 at National Fire Service College, Nagpur or any of the Regional Training Centre (RTC) identified by the College. The duration of the Sub Officers Course is 33 weeks out of which 21 weeks will be conducted at the RTC and 12 weeks practical attachment at major Fire Services in the country at the discretion of the College.

The entrance examination is proposed to be held at **Delhi, Mumbai, Kolkata, Chennai and Nagpur.** The date, time and venue of the examination will be intimated individually to eligible candidates by email only. **The Director, National Fire Service College reserves the rights to change, add new centre or delete the existing centre at any time without assigning any reason.**

All the details such as eligibility, age, fees, examination etc are given below.

**Eligibility:**

1. **Age:** - Candidates applying for the ensuing All India Entrance Examination should be between 18 and 25 years as on **01/01/2020**. Upper age limit is relaxable by 5 years for SC/ST candidates and 3 years for OBC candidates.(OBC candidates will have to provide OBC caste certificate and Self Declaration as prescribed in the advertisement) All reserved candidates will be required to produce relevant valid documents as a proof of caste for obtaining age relaxation as required by the Government of India. The candidates availing age relaxation for SC/ST or OBC will be as per Government Rules
2. **Educational Qualifications:-** Graduate from recognized University or 3 years Diploma in any branch of Engineering recognized by A.I.C.T.E. or Board of Technical Education. Candidates must be able to read, write, speak both in Hindi and English. Candidates should have passed the qualifying examination **as on or before 31<sup>st</sup> August 2019.**

**3. Physical Standard:-**

- (a) **For Male Minimum:-** Height: 165 cms. (Relaxable by 5 cms in the case of Nepali, Garhwalls, Assamese, Gorkha & Nagaland tribes).  
Chest: 81 cms unexpanded with minimum expansion of 5 cms  
Weight: min. 50 kgs.
- (b) **For Female Minimum:-** Height: 157 cms. (Relaxable by 2.5 cms in the case of Garhwalls, Assamese, Gorkha & Nagaland tribes).  
Weight: min. 46 kgs.

**4. Medical Standard:-**

- (a) Visual: Better eye-6/6 (Eligible vision-6/6 only) **without aid.**
- (b) Color vision:- No colour blindness.
- (c) The candidate must **not** have knock-nee, flat feet, squint eyes and stammering. They must be in good mental and bodily health and free from any physical defect.

**5. Last date for receipt for online Application:** - The last date for filling online application form is **29/09/2019**

**6. Examination Fees:-**

a) **Fees shall be paid by Online Payment through NEFT and ANY GENERATED REF.No./TRANSACTION No./UTR No. should be FILLED in the appropriate column of the application form .**

b) Fee for unreserved and OBC candidates = ₹ 100/-

(c) Fee for SC/ST candidates = ₹  
25/-

(d) Application form without fees or less fees will be rejected.

7. The Admit card will sent to those candidates found eligible as per eligibility rules for the written examination

8. **Written** The examination will be conducted in one session on **13/10/2019 (Sunday)** The entrance Examination will have objective type question which will based on 12<sup>th</sup> Science syllabus. The Composition of the question paper will be as follows:-

(1)	General Knowledge	50 Marks
(2)	General English	50 Marks
(3)	Science& Mathematics	100 Marks (In Science question will be asked purely on physics and Chemistry)

The Question paper will be printed bilingually (Hindi & English)except General English . The question paper will be objective type and will consist of questions from Science and Mathematics also.

9. **Examination Centres:** - The Entrance Examination is proposed to be held at **Delhi, Mumbai, Kolkata, Chennai & Nagpur**. Centre of Examination may be changed at the discretion of the College. The exact address of the Examination Centre will be intimated individually to the eligible candidates.

10. **Seats:-** There are a total of 30 seats for each batch of 45<sup>th</sup> & 46<sup>th</sup> External Sub Officers Course. The reservations for SC, ST and OBC will be as per Government of India norms. The Course shall begin in January 2020 and July 2020. Any Seats left vacant will be filled from respective vacant Category.

11. **Payment of TA/DA: Candidates are not eligible for any TA/DA from the College.**

12. **Grant of Admission:-** Admission will be granted to the candidates based on the overall order of merit on the basis of written examination and as per the rules of reservation. Results will be communicated individually to the selected candidates **by email ONLY**.

13. The originals of all the documents shall have to be produced when the candidate appears for document verification. Submission of original documents at later date will not be permitted.

**(IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS)**

1. Application form should be filled online only. All the columns of the prescribed form must be completely filled.
2. Application with signature in capital letters will be rejected.
3. The last date for filling online application form is **29/09/2019**.
4. Only those candidates found eligible for the written examination will be sent Admit Card.
5. The candidates should periodically check their Mail-Id for any communication from NFSC regarding Admit Card etc, NFSC will display the list of candidates selected to appear in the Entrance Examination on its website [www.nfscnagpur.nic.in](http://www.nfscnagpur.nic.in).
6. The course is residential and Lodging and Boarding is compulsory . The charges for accommodation mentioned in our Website and mentioned in the order intimating the allotment of seats is only indicative. The actual fees for accommodation and food may vary depending on the Regional Training Centre to which the candidates are admitted.

7. The candidates will have to produce the original documents in support of their academic qualification and claim for reservation for belonging to particular category at the time of admission also. The candidates claiming reservation under OBC category shall have to produce a certificate in the format prescribed.
